The STEMM Children's Village

There is no more powerful example of our precept to be spirit-led than the presence of our orphanage.

Nowhere in our original charter of our founding fathers vision existed even the faintest thought or dream of running an orphanage. But in 2007 we were called by the Holy Spirit to take a more active role in caring for the children of Tanzania in a loving Christian environment.

For almost a decade now we have provided a loving nurturing environment for 24 beautiful children who are not excluded because of their HIV status or other malady. Our orphanage was selected as the best run orphanage in our district and the second-best orphanage in all northern Tanzania. Most importantly, we have transformed the lives of two dozen children who had absolutely no hope into a new generation of loving equipped Christian leaders.

In June 2019 we opened two more orphan houses to double our capacity to 48 children. Each of our four homes are created to nurture the children in a loving Christian environment growing up in a home with mamas, aunts and their new brothers and sisters in Christ.

You have a wonderful opportunity to sponsor one of our STEMM children for \$125/mo (\$1,500/year) which will provide each of them with all the necessities of food, shelter, clothing, and education. STEMM UPDATE



As I prepared to write this brief summation of our yearly and current activities all I can think of is WOW! The breadth of our activities and the impact we are making continues to expand and improve thanks to your continuing generous support of our ministry!

Education

During our first year, we were able to send four children to high school and, as is often the case when doing God's work, our goals and aspirations were far too humble. Now, in our 22nd year, STEMM has sponsored over 10,000 students gain the gift of education. Throughout northern Tanzania, STEMM Education Coordinators, Elizabeth and Moses are mentoring over 150 high school and college students annually. With your support, our goal is to be able to support over 200 students in the next year.

Spiritual

Spirit-Led...Relationally-Driven

When we share our ministries, we often focus on what we do, instead of why we are doing it. The inspiration and purpose behind all our ministries are spiritual. We are seeking to follow in the footsteps of Christ by serving others and showing them the path to Jesus.

In similar manner, we find that first identifying and meeting people's earthly needs in Christian love and compassion, allows for relationships with them and consequently an opening into their eternal soul. Make no mistake, we desire to, and are most definitely making the world a better place for thousands of Tanzanians. But our commitment and our passion are to make God's eternal kingdom a busier place. In other words, we exist truly as an evangelistic-minded organization.

Our very reason for existing is to develop a deep enough relationship both with mission seekers in the U.S. as well as Tanzanians to introduce them to God's amazing and all-encompassing love. And then to support, encourage and disciple them to "Seek first the Kingdom of God." This is possible only by our daily consistent modeling of Christ-like love both here and Tanzania. Medical

From our first trip, it became apparent that a tremendous impact could be made through medical outreach. In the beginning, our medical efforts were centered primarily on performing orthopedic surgery on children with congenital deformities. As our ministry has expanded, several orthopedic surgeons and other medical personnel have served during STEMM trips.

In 2019, a concerted effort was made to increase our medical mission trips. This year STEMM was blessed to have many volunteers serve the people and children of Tanzania. Our Medical mission trips included a Physical Therapist and Physical Therapy students, Nurses and Nursing students, Pre-Med Student, Nurse Practitioners, Physicians and Dentists. We are working with Morningside College, Briar Cliff University and Dordt College to offer trips to healthcare students. It is a tremendous blessing to be able to use God-given talents to serve Him.

Increasingly, we have been directing our efforts toward medical education. We take every opportunity to teach native physicians and nurses in many areas of hands-on health care training. Medical mission volunteers spent many hours teaching important skills to aid in the care of the villagers.

Orphanage

It has been an exciting year as we opened our 2 new orphanage buildings in June thus expanding our capability to have twenty-four more children join our STEMM family. The blessing of providing a family and home for a total of forty-eight children is humbling. We have begun taking in the children on our waiting list. Our first child on the waiting list is Rose. In June she was able to join her sister Neema who already lives at SCV. It is so exciting to see that siblings are being reunited as we continue to accept other children. Just past month we welcome 11 new orphan children and will be bringing 14 more in the next month. Your support for our children and orphanage operations are greatly appreciated.



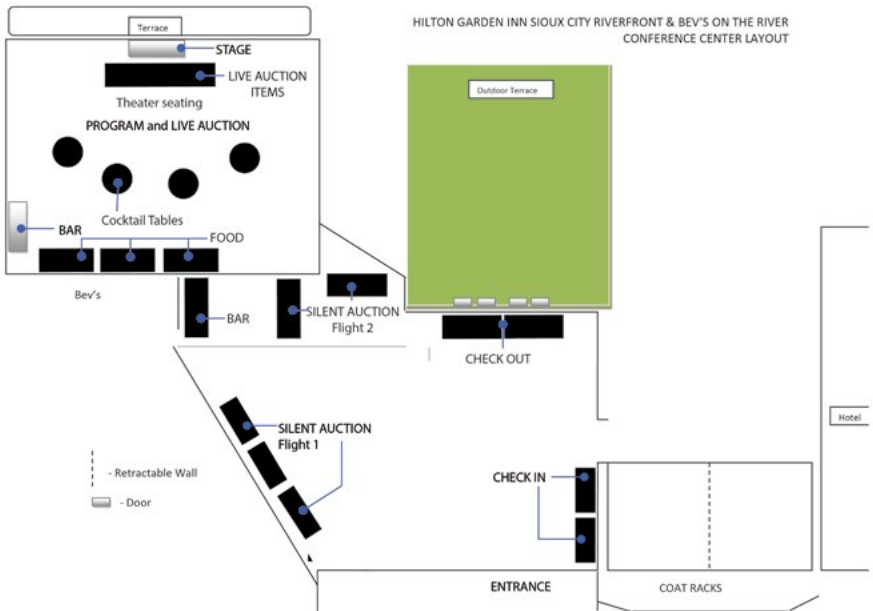
Bidding Procedures

When people ask me, which they frequently do, how the *Miracle Kids* are doing, I always say “miraculously.” And that’s not being

Before this all happened my entire country had forgotten about God, but now that they have seen the miracles that happened for the three of us they now believe in God and are going back to church!!!”

Wow !!! What an amazing perspective from a 13-year-old African child!!!! What more can be said of the *Miracle Kids* of Tanzania.

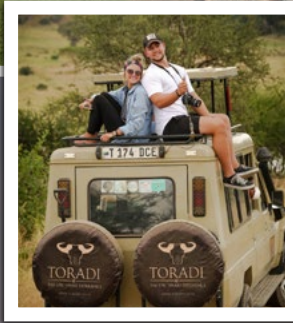

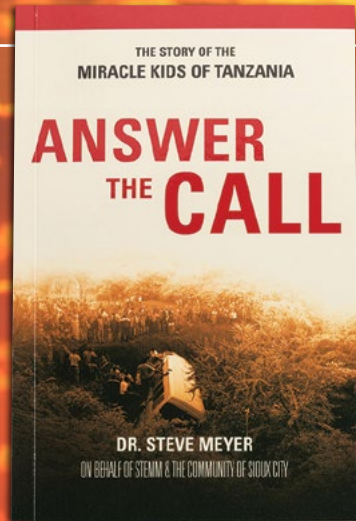

THE GIFT OF EDUCATION

From the onset of STEMM, the education of Tanzanian children has been our highest priority. The initial goal of our organization was to afford education to the brightest and neediest Tanzanian children. In a country where less than 8% of children graduate from high school, a gift of an education is truly life changing. During our first year, we were able to send four children to high school and, as is often the case when doing God's work, our goals and aspirations were far too humble. After sponsoring over 10,000 students through high school and university, now we made a strategic decision to invest more resources in mentorship and leadership training for our students. In that light we are currently financially sponsoring over 400 high school and college students this year.

Today, our students consistently perform in the top 10-20% of all children throughout the country on their national exams. These children have demonstrated a great desire to learn and better their lives – they simply need the opportunity. That is where STEMM comes in. STEMM is trying to make their dream a reality. As a result, we need continual financial expansion to support these children to a higher level of proficiency through university and trade school level education.

Out and about

Community Outreach



The Spirit-Led, Relationally driven, mission of STEMM extends to the community and villages around STEMM Children's Village. The opportunities for Christian outreach are unlimited.

FEEDING PROGRAM

In 2017, a partnership began between local primary schools and STEMM to provide one hot meal to each child per school day. School administrators and parents donate beans, maize and firewood. STEMM donates money to build a kitchen, pay the cook's salary, and buy cooking oil and salt. As of May 2019, we work with 8 schools feeding 5,500 students. The program affects attendance first and foremost.

Children who know they have a meal are much more likely to go to school and be more attentive and engaged. In the past there has been hesitation for families to send their children to school as household duties and chores take priority. If students are in class more, they are more likely to spend enough time on

lessons, learn the information, and graduate. We have seen incredible improvements in attendance and graduation rates: up from 38% to 90%. Those that pass move on to Secondary School, whereas those who fail are destined to a life of unrealized potential. This program helps challenge the status quo and pushes for positive change, but most importantly invests in the future generation of Tanzanians.

CLEAN WATER

STEMM realized that clean water was not available in the villages, so upon the initial building of STEMM Children's Village, we began the well and water tank project by providing water piped to the outside community. At the Mbuguni and Tanzanite schools, the construction of a well and water tower provides clean water for school children and for the school's farmland for irrigation.

DAYS FOR GIRLS

STEMM has volunteers that make Days for Girls kits that are given to the girls at the schools. The majority of girls miss school one week a month because they do not have menstrual care products. Days for Girls kits provides safe, washable, solution along with the vital health education.

ECO-TOURISM

A relationship with the Maasai village of Nakweni is developing to encourage and support "Cultural

Charity Tourism". This is an amazing opportunity to be welcomed into a realm that people rarely get to see. Mission trip volunteers can spend the day in the life of a Maasai. The cost of this experience goes directly into a community fund for the village. We work hand in hand to solve the most pressing needs of the village and its people. To empower and educate the women in the Maasai village, we have initiated a beading project to make belts. We also educate the women in the village regarding health issues regarding pregnancy and childbirth.

SIFE

Briar Cliff College SIFE (Students in Free Enterprise) program has been sending students for years to SCV to continue their community development by bringing their project of small business loans to local women. They now have women, who had no income before, able to provide for their families through jobs of basket making and raising chickens. The women repay the loans with interest which is used to provide loans to more women.

CLEAN UP MBUGUNI CAMPAIGN

We instigated a new idea to the villagers this past year. Three days per week, the entire Mbuguni village cleans up their community. STEMM provides the dumpsters and trash is picked up which has made a huge difference in the living conditions.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION

As STEMM volunteers go on mission trips, they use their talents as teachers, nurses, medical students, dentists, physical therapists, and social workers to teach and educate at the schools and medical clinic. STEMM knows that it is

important to empower as we serve the people of Tanzania.

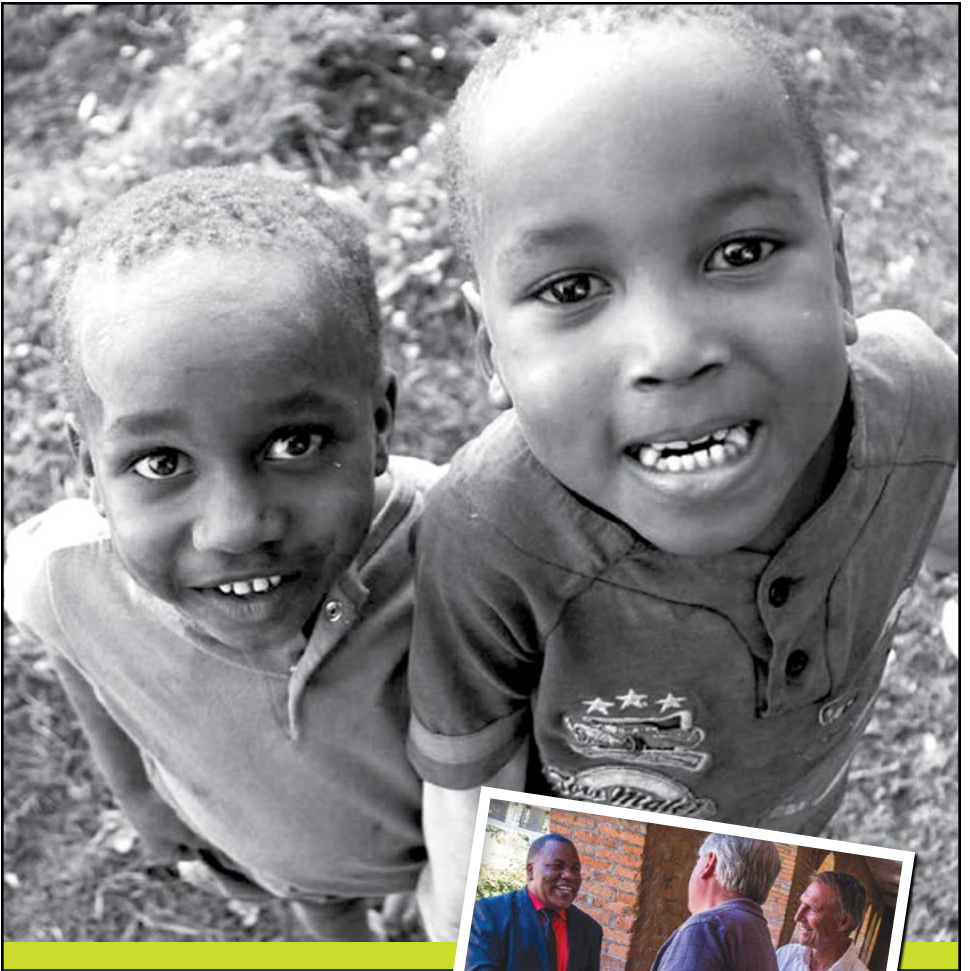
MEDICAL OUTREACH

We have begun partnering with the local medical clinic to provide outreach clinics to rural areas near our orphanage. It allows access to health services the villagers would not otherwise have. We identify and treat diseases and send severe cases onto larger institutions for care. It is an amazing way to donate to a specific patient and lifesaving in many situations. With our ongoing teams we document each patient and pass these along to the next team for consistency in patient follow up care.

BIRTHING CENTER

We continue to support The life changing benefit of our birthing center built in collaboration with abod is demonstrated by the deliveries per month at the local clinic exploding from 4-80 per month. This facility has been equipped with fetal doppler, oxygen, IV supplies and a modern birthing bed. Teams continue to volunteer and train staff and assist in deliveries. Through this we assure the safe and comfortable delivery of their children.
